Abstract: Quizlet is a great tool and resource when helping students understand vocabulary. This tool is a free online resource that provides students with flashcards. As a teacher, you can create your own Quizlet, or you can navigate to find flashcards that have already been made according to the subject/content. Quizlet users have created over 400 million sets of flashcards. These sets range from AP courses, elementary classes/subjects, different languages, and even extensive vocabulary lists.

Personal Experience: I used Quizlet to aid my students in their vocabulary list this past week. Every Monday, students are given 8 new vocabulary words. I quickly created my own list with the words and the definitions then had students look through them. Students played a matching game and I was able to log in and check their progress. In the future, I think it would be beneficial to give the vocabulary quiz entirely online and not on paper. I think this would save paper, allow for students to utilize the tool, and save me time or grading. Outside of vocabulary, I think this would be a great resource to use in science, social studies, or even reading. Students could use this tool when studying for tests or quizes and it keeps them engaged and motivated. It would be great to track their progress so I would be able to differentiate for the students that were struggling.
